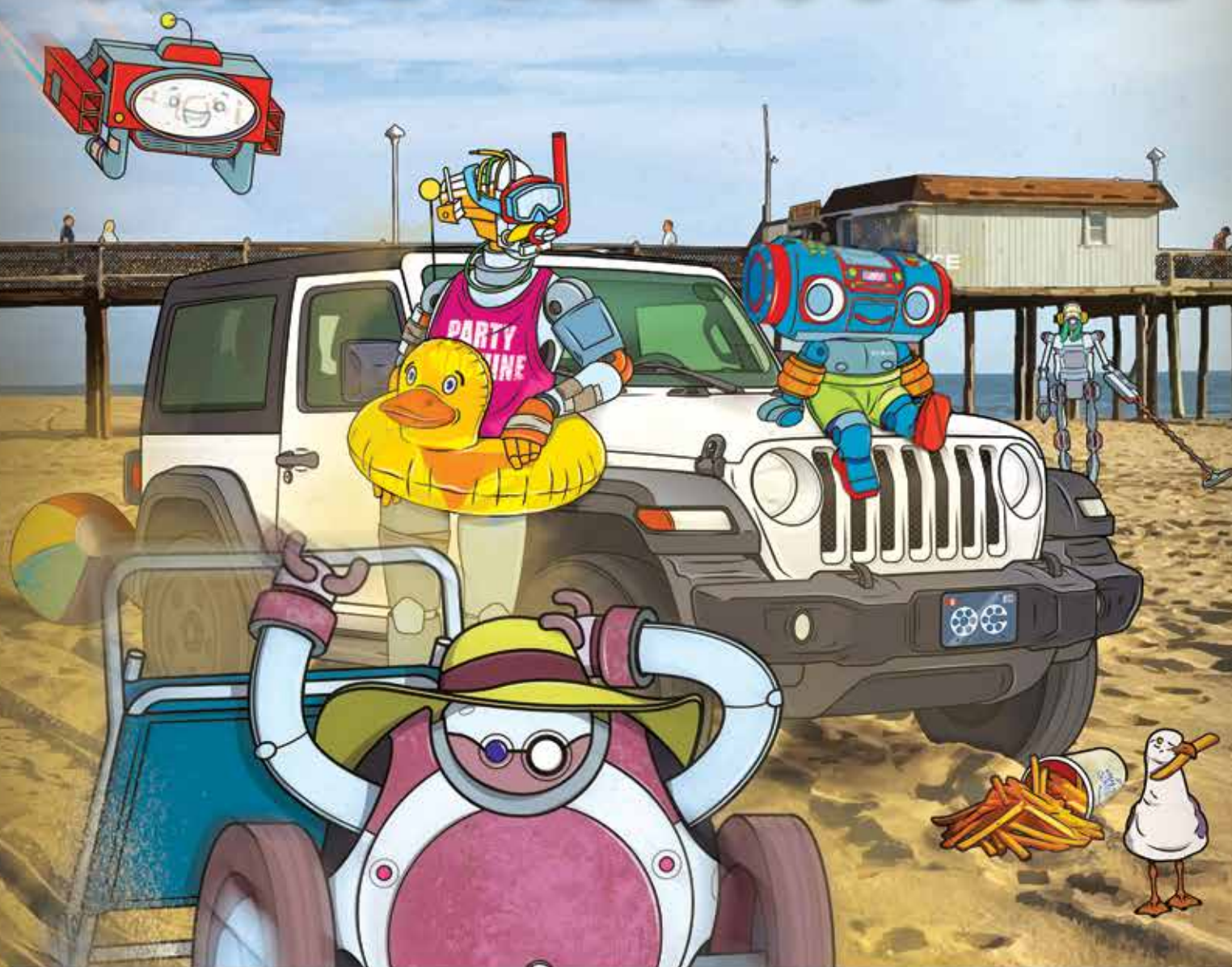

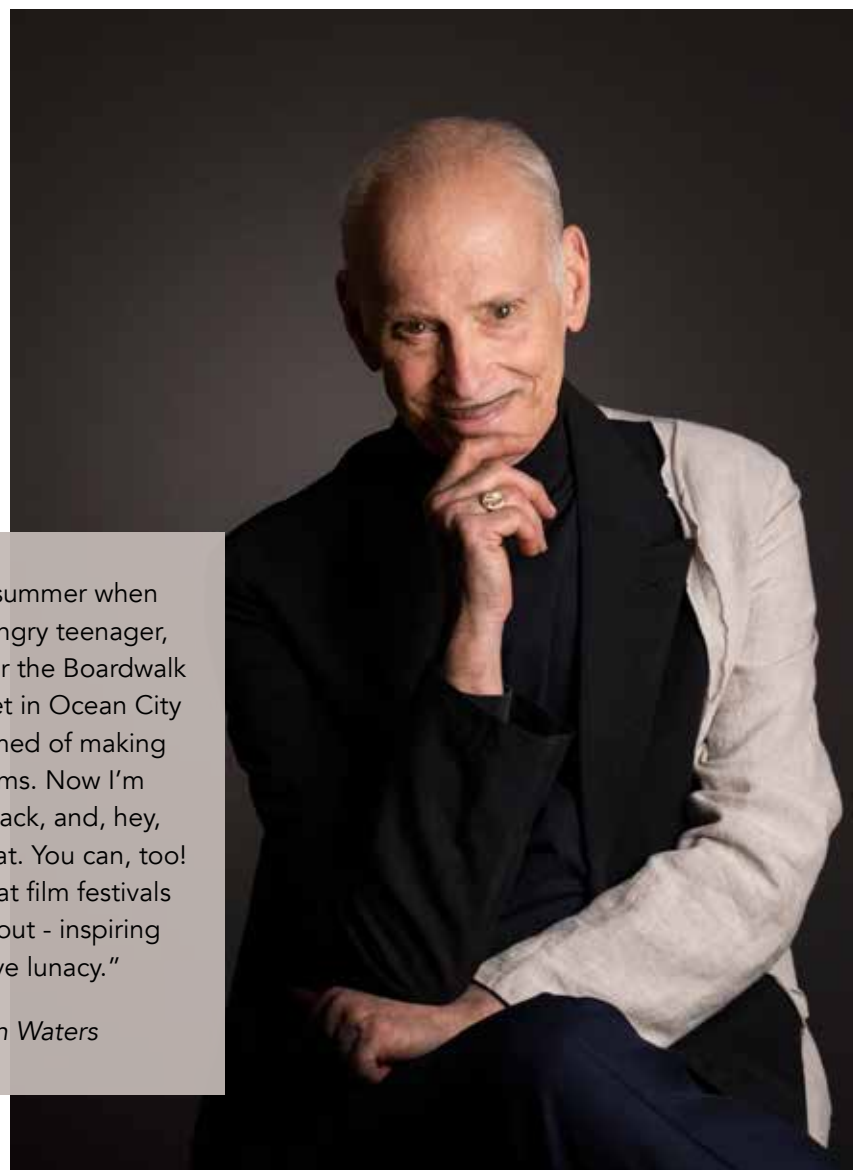
If you were a teenager in Baltimore in the 1960s, you and your friends would race home from school every day to gather in front of the black-and-white TV in the living room and watch the Buddy Deane Show. The iconic local music and dance show starred a group of kids nicknamed The Committee, who were the coolest kids in town - and all white. Every couple of weeks, the show would host an all-Black "Negro Day," but refused to integrate

the races. After John Waters attended a reunion of the Buddy Deane Show in the 1980s, the idea for his movie "Hairspray" was sparked. "All fiction based on a little bit of truth" is how Waters describes the film. But The Committee kids who were present during Hairspray's filming said the movie set was so similar to the real thing, it felt like being in an episode of the Twilight Zone.

Waters has said that Hairspray was his "one special obsession that didn't scare people." Hear him talk about his inspiration for the movie, his memories of the Buddy Deane Show, and other eye-popping comments on the movie during a live performance on March 9 in Ocean City.
